The revision of the electoral roll is a constitutional provision. After the recent transfer of power, the new government in this country sought at least to guarantee the people their right to vote. Hence, the central objective of revising the voter list was *inclusion*. This process has been carried out multiple times in keeping with that ideal. Since the 1990s, the revision of voter lists has been conducted regularly—and now, it is done every year on a regional basis.

Even so, the sudden call for an intensive revision drive just before the elections—creating panic among ordinary people, threatening them with deletion from the rolls, and invoking the specter of the so-called “Bangladeshi enemy”—has generated a climate of fear that is profoundly unconstitutional.
